Today we escape to the Yarra Valley. Our first stop is to Coombe Melba Estate, one of the largest and oldest family estates in the Yarra Valley. The history, beauty and romance of the estate makes it a unique place to visit and to enjoy a Devonshire Tea. Once the home of Dame Nellie Melba, we'll soak in the surroundings of this stunning location and gain a great understanding into the world of Dame Melba with a stroll through the gallery and garden. Lunch today is overlooking the peaceful vineyard at Fergusson Winery. The restaurant oozes rustic charm and hand sawn furniture, an infamous wall of barrels and is matched with delicious locally farmed cuisine. Before leaving this region, we call into Yarra Valley Chocolaterie and Ice Creamery. We'll be welcomed with chocolate tastings, displays of thousands of premium handcrafted chocolates where you can indulge and purchase your favourites.

Friday 27 March
